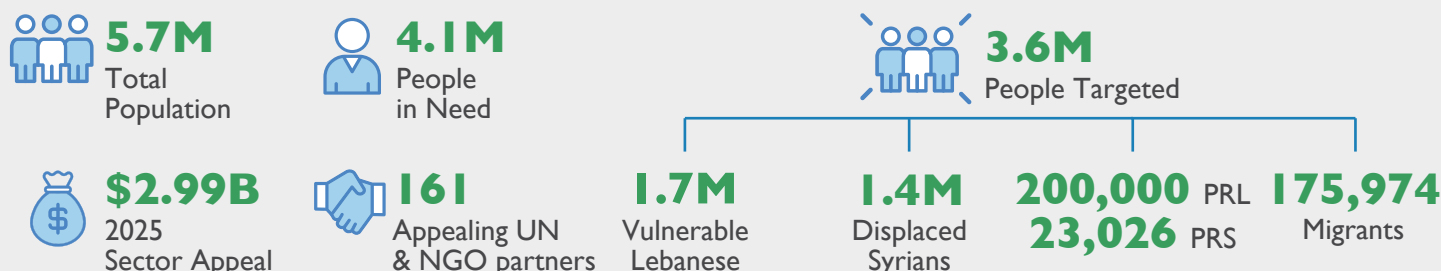

Ensure protection of the vulnerable populations.

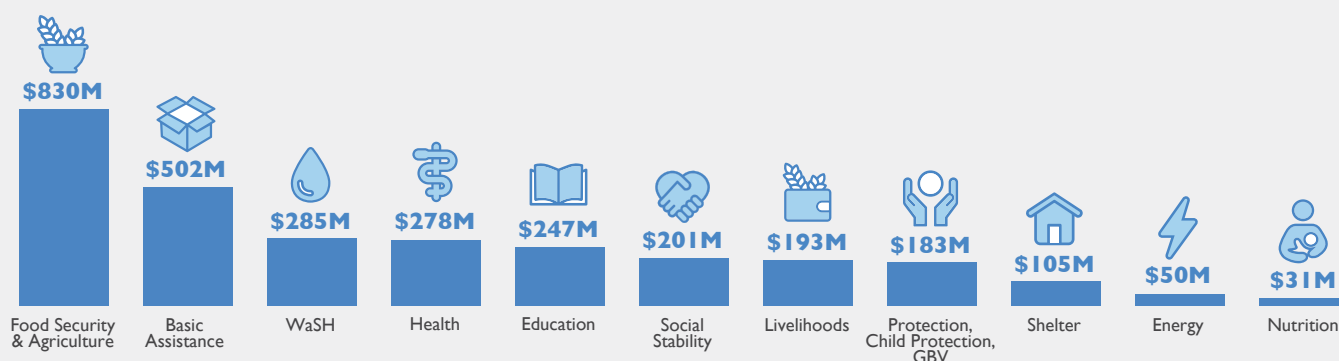


Support service provision through national systems including national rapid response capacity.

2025 Funding Requirement by Sector

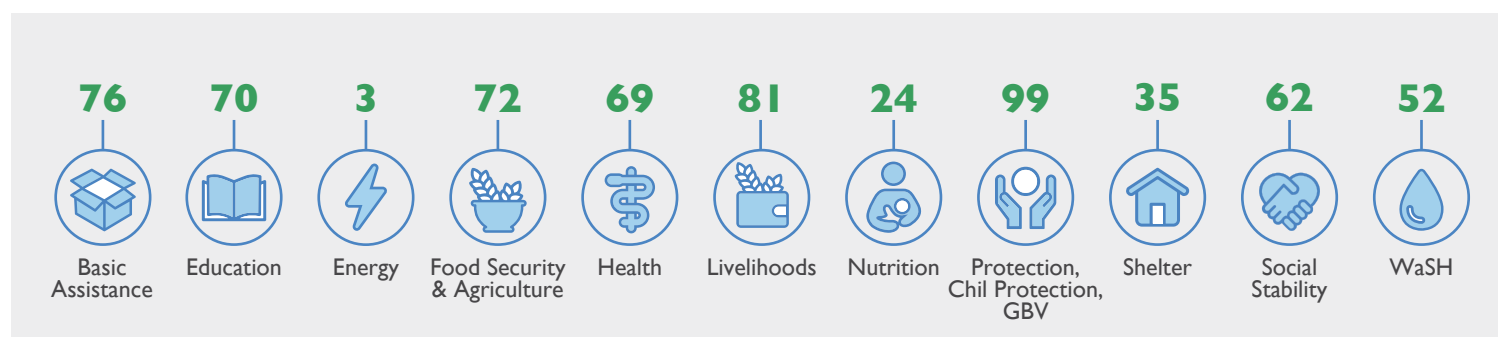

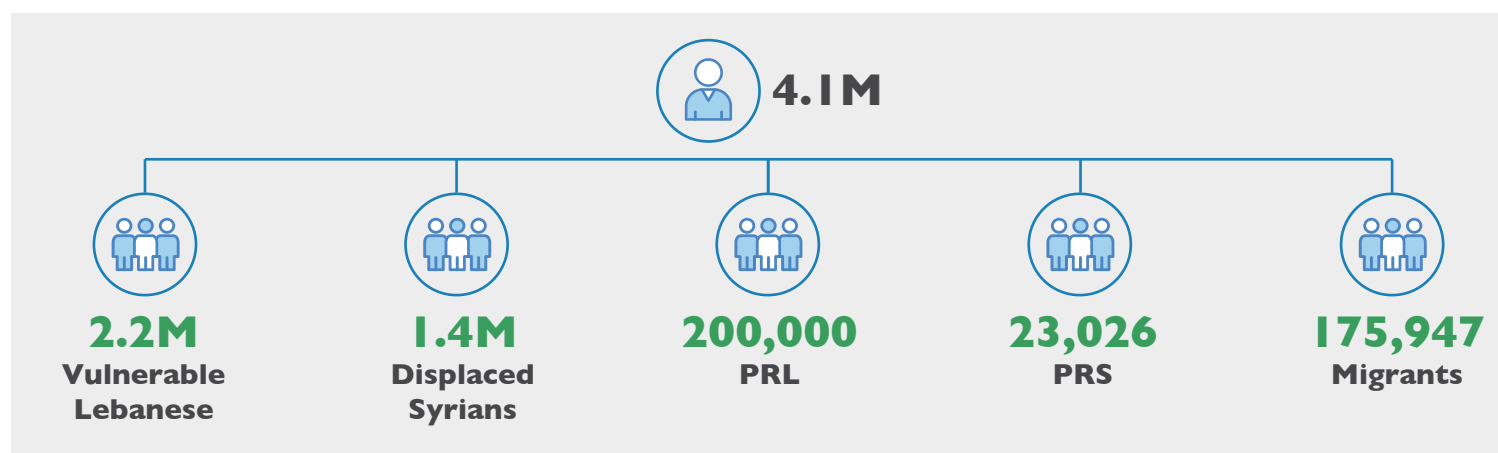
